ABOUT THIS BOOK

The Bible is a BIG book—too big to read from end to end in one sitting. But this is a book designed to help young readers grasp the BIG story that the Bible tells. It organizes the Bible into 10 frames or “snapshots” that define the major movements in the story. It also introduces Bible verses for every letter of the alphabet along the way. Just as a person sings through the ABCs, the Bible’s amazing story can be followed from A to Z by memorizing these verses.

There is, of course, more to the Bible than what these 10 frames depict. But the pictures, summaries, and Scripture verses try to faithfully communicate God’s story in a succinct and memorable way, inviting us to see ourselves within it. So let this book help you get into God’s Word so more of God’s Word can get into you.

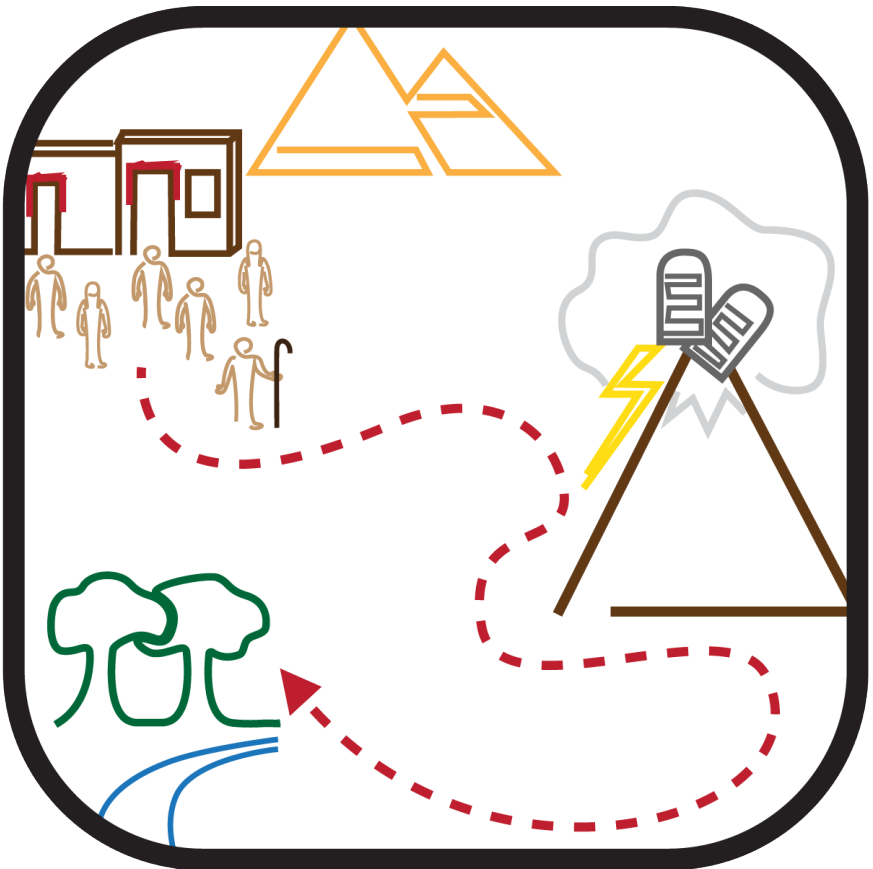
God said to Abraham, “As for you, you must keep my covenant, you and your descendants in every generation.

6. EXILE

Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved.


