Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone at the table answer this question: “How does knowing Jesus is alive and not dead give you hope for the things in your life?”



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: “What are some things that seem impossible?”



Bed Time

Pray for each other: “Jesus, help us remember that whatever happens, it’s not too much for You. You overcame death and rose from the grave.”
