Meal Time

Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: “How are you and your friends alike? How are you different?”



Bed Time

Pray for each other: “Jesus, thank You for accepting us. May we be accepting of those around us who are different in some way. May we show them kindness. May we show them how much You care about them too.”
