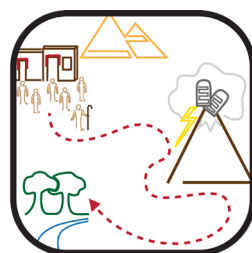

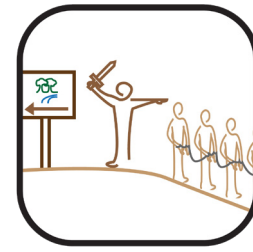
I I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery. *Exodus 20:2 NIV*

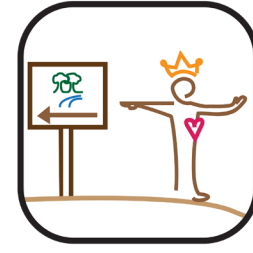


EXILE

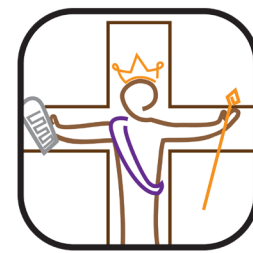


PROMISE
