Talk About the Bible Story

Easter

Matthew 26:36, 47-50; 27:1-2,
11-66; 28:1-8

People hurt Jesus, and He dies. On the third day, Jesus comes back and is alive forever!

MEMORY VERSE

"I am alive forever and ever!"

Revelation 1:18, NIV

Engagement Questions

- Who is alive?
- Who wants to be your friend forever?

Prayer

"Dear God, thank You that Jesus is alive. Jesus is Your Son, and we are so thankful Jesus wants to be our friend forever. We love You, God. In Jesus' name. Amen."



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! Happy Easter! Today is the happiest of happy days because Jesus is alive!"



Drive Time

While on the go, look for things that are alive. Animals, plants, and people are a great place to start. Talk about how Jesus is alive forever and ever. (Revelation 1:18) That's a long time!



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "Dear God, thank You for loving us so much that You gave us Your Son, Jesus. Thank You that Jesus died and came back, just like He said He would. Thank You that Jesus is alive and wants to be our friend forever. We love You, God!"



Bath Time

Add an item to bath time that will pop up when pushed under water (like a bouncy ball). Show your child how to hold the item under water. Tell your child to let go of the item after you count to three together. When the item pops out of the water, say: "Jesus is alive!"
